Junior Master Gardener Classes at Greystone Mansion & Gardens *Register Kids Now for 8-Week Course Beginning in January*



Beverly Hills, Calif. – Junior Master Gardener Classes at Greystone Mansion & Gardens for kids 6 years to 12 years of age begins January 10 through March 20. The eight-week program is at Greystone Demonstration Garden at Greystone Mansion & Gardens: The Doheny Estate, 905 Loma Vista Drive in Beverly Hills.

The Junior Master Gardener Classes are through the University of California Cooperative Extension and are taught by certified master gardeners. The program provides children with an outdoor venue where they come together to learn how to grow a vegetable garden and the benefits of locally grown, organic food that is environmentally friendly, sustainable and cost-effective. Participants will work on projects that develop critical thinking skills and entrepreneurial skills, as well as gain self-confidence through project presentations. Children who complete the program will receive the Golden Ray Certificate from Texas A & M University's Junior Master Gardener Program.
