SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- 05/03/2016 At approximately 2:30 AM, officers received an Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) notification of a stolen vehicle near Santa Monica Blvd and Beverly Dr. The vehicle was located and the suspects attempted to flee until they lost control and crashed the vehicle. One suspect was immediately arrested and the second suspect was located after a K-9 search of the area.
- 05/06/2016 At approximately midnight, officers stopped a vehicle with no license plates at Wetherly Dr. and Wilshire Blvd. After a short investigation, officer recovered a loaded firearm with a high capacity magazine. The suspect was arrested without incident.
- 05/06/2016 At approximately 4:30 AM, officers responded to a reported robbery at Wilshire Blvd. and La Cienega Blvd. Upon arrival, the suspect was located and taken into custody for grand theft.
- 05/09/2016 At approximately 7:30 PM, officers responded to a call of a Hit and Run Driver in the area of Robertson Blvd and Olympic Blvd. The vehicle was located in an alley a short distance away. The suspect attempted to fight with the officers and was taken into custody.
- 05/09/2016 At approximately 8 AM, officers responded to a robbery in the 300 Block of North Crescent Dr. Upon arrival, officers located the suspect vehicle which was unoccupied. Detectives were contacted and located and arrested the suspect at 3:45 PM.
- 05/15/2016 At approximately midnight, officers stopped a vehicle with no plates and three occupants. After an investigation, it was determined the vehicle was stolen out of West Los Angeles. The suspects were linked to numerous crimes in Los Angeles and subsequently arrested.
- 05/16/2016 At approximately 10 AM, officers responded to a bank robbery in the 9400 block of Wilshire Blvd. Officers eventually located the suspect in West Los Angeles, arrested him and recovered the money.
- 05/17/2016 At approximately 2 PM, officers responded to Van Cleef and Arpel's for possible forgery suspects. The suspects were located and after an investigation, they were arrested for forgery.
- 05/17/2016 At approximately 3 PM, officers responded to a bank robbery in progress in the 9300 block of Wilshire Blvd. The suspect was located inside the bank and taken into custody.
- 05/18/2016 Officers observed a male in the area of La Peer Drive and Wilshire Blvd riding a bike and looking into parked vehicles. As officers approached the suspect, he attempted to flee but was detained for questioning. It was determined that he has a one million dollar warrant for assault with a deadly weapon and was on parole. He was arrested; bolt cutters and other burglary tools were discovered in the suspect's property.
- 05/31/2016 At approximately 4 AM, officers observed a commercial burglary take place in the 400 block of North Roxbury Drive. Two suspects fled the area and were subsequently located and arrested after an extensive K-9 search.

DETECTIVE BUREAU

- 05/04/2016 DNA evidence testing led to charges being filed against Edward Felton for a residential burglary that took place on 01/09/2016. Felton is currently in custody and his maximum exposure is seven years in state prison.
- 05/09/2016 After committing a reported armed robbery in a city parking structure, detective personnel were able to identify, to locate, and eventually arrested Kali Suzanne Woods in the Hollywood area. Following the BH robbery, she committed a home invasion robbery followed by an attempted fraudulent transaction at nearby bank in Los Angeles. A full confession was obtained leading to a guilty plea and a four-year prison sentence.
- 05/22/2016 Assault with a Deadly Weapon charges were filed against DeTroy Hawthorne for his actions against two Beverly Hills police officers who were injured during the above incident.

05/25/2016 Detectives obtained a court order to restrict the phone calls for a county jail inmate who was identified as being responsible for the numerous false emergency (shooting) calls which have taken place in the last several weeks. Since then, phone calls of this type have ceased.

05/31/2016 Multiple charges were filed on two commercial burglars who were responsible for two Beverly Hills pharmacy burglaries at the time of their arrest. Additional charges were filed by the LA County District Attorney's Office in connection with several pharmacy burglaries in Beverly Hills and other areas of Los Angeles County.

05/10/2016 Traffic Bureau implemented a traffic plan to close the 300 block of North Rodeo Drive for 33 hours for the YPO event.
