

Success of Water Leak Program

Date	Leaks < 1 gpm	Avg Flow/Min.	Flow/Billing Cycle
January, 2016	19	1.9 gpm	3,171,024 gallons
April, 2016	4	1.8 gpm	632,448 gallons
Savings Per Billing Cycle	80% reduction	3,393 units	2,538,576 gallons

Water Audits



1. Mainly for residential, large landscapes
2. Resident to pay a portion of the audit
3. Focused on outdoor watering
4. Conducted by outside contractor
5. Water savings with this program are award winning



Water Leak Program

1. Contact customers on both leak lists (residential and commercial) on a regular basis
2. Educate the community on how to look for repair a leak via: outreach



Multifamily Program

1. Direct Install toilet program
2. Educate everyone in building on continuous flow issues



Single Family Program

1. Water audits
 1. Larger by consulting firm
 2. Smaller by staff
2. Promote rebates
3. Offer free showerheads and free hose nozzles with shut off
4. Outreach to community at local events
5. Water wise landscaping workshops



Business Program

For BOMA, Restaurants, Hotels, Etc.

1. Water Audits
2. Workshops
3. Cooling tower rebate assistance
(via MWD's program)
4. Leak detection education
5. Rebates and Devices
