## **SIGNIFICANT EVENTS**

- 02/05/2016 At approximately 5PM, officers recognized a suspicious vehicle in the Trowsdale area. The vehicle was stopped and all three suspects were arrested for suspicion of residential burglary.
- 02/05/2016 Officers observed a reckless driver on Wilshire Blvd. After a short pursuit, the vehicle was stopped and the driver was arrested.
- 02/08/2016 At approximately 1:30AM, officers observed a suspect illuminating the interior of parked cars. A short time later the suspect was stopped in his vehicle where stolen property, burglary tools and narcotics were recovered. The suspect was arrested.
- 02/12/2016 At approximately 3AM, officers located a stolen vehicle traveling south on La Cienega Blvd. The vehicle was stopped and the driver was subsequently arrested.
- 02/17/2016 At approximately 4AM, officers stopped a bicyclist without lighting near Maple and Alden Dr. After brief investigation the subject was taken into custody for possession of narcotics, burglary tools and stolen property.
- 02/20/2016 Officers received an ALPR notification of an Armed and Dangerous vehicle on Wilshire Blvd. The vehicle was wanted in connection with an Attempt Murder. After stopping the vehicle, West Hollywood Deputies responded taking the subject into custody.
- 02/21/2016 Officers received an ALPR notification of a stolen vehicle on Sunset Blvd. The vehicle was located as it pulled into a random driveway. Both suspects fled on foot and after a short perimeter, both were located and arrested.
- 02/22/2016 At approximately 5AM, officers stopped two subjects and after an investigation discovered that they had burglarized the Black and White Rental Car agency. Both suspects were taken into custody.
- 02/23/2016 At approximately 4AM, officers observed a parked vehicle with engine running and no plates in an alley. At the conclusion of the investigation, both occupants were arrested for auto theft, possession of burglary tools and warrants.
- 02/25/2016 At approximately 11AM, officers stopped a suspicious person in the 200 block of N La Peer. After a short investigation the subject was arrested for an auto theft warrant, possession of burglary tools and drug paraphernalia.

## **DETECTIVE BUREAU**

- 02/02/2016 During January of 2016, a joint investigation began involving Beverly Hills and LAPD detective personnel. The investigation focused on a prolific burglar who had repeatedly targeted both cities. As a result of the joint effort, on February 2, 2016, BHPD detective personnel obtained a 25 count criminal filing with the District Attorney for the suspect involved in the crimes, John David Ferenz.
- 03/18/2016 While conducting a Residential Burglary suppression operation, police personnel identified Lance Broussard driving a stolen van in the northern section of Beverly Hills. Broussard was ultimately arrested, and it was determined he had a lengthy arrest record for numerous theft related crimes. The District Attorney has charged Broussard for the vehicle theft, and he faces as many as 10 years in state prison due to his extensive criminal history.
- 03/24/2016 Three minors entered an eating establishment located in the 8400 block of Wilshire BLVD and brandished a replica handgun. Detective personnel, who were in the immediate area, successfully detained the minors at the scene of the offence. As a result of the investigation, all three minors were arrested for trespassing and brandishing a replica weapon at a place of business. The three minor's cases are currently pending preliminary hearings in Juvenile Court system.

## **TRAFFIC BUREAU**

- 02/14/2016 the 2016 LA Marathon raced through Beverly Hills. Traffic Bureau personnel, other Department personnel and volunteers successfully implemented and Event Action Plan and new Event Traffic Plan. No major incidents, related to the race, were reported.

- 02/28/2016 The Vanity Fair event took place on Crescent Drive in front of City Hall. Traffic Bureau personnel and other Department personnel implemented and Event Action Plan and new Event Traffic Plan. No major incidents, related to the event, were reported.
- 02/01/2016 On-going -TCO's & Commercial Enforcement Officer continue to rove the Trousdale area to ensure compliance with the City Councils heavy hauling guidelines.
- 02/10/2016 Motor Officers conducted a special enforcement operation for pedestrian and U-Turn violations on S. Beverly from 1900-2100 hours which resulted in 6 moving citations, 5 warnings, 5 parking cites and one vehicle impound.
- 02/19/2016 The Traffic Bureau, in conjunction with the CHP, conducted a commercial vehicle inspection operation on Doheny Road at Loma Vista from 0800-1200 hours, which resulted in 22 vehicle inspections, 4 impounds, 3 out of service vehicles and 14 citations.

### **PERSONNEL & TRAINING BUREAU**

- 03/05/2016 During the month of February, staff processed 102 entry-level and 9 lateral police applicants for the police officer position and 10 applicants for the police cadet position. In addition, 1 police officer and 2 Traffic Control Officer were hired during the month of February.
