Commercial Recycling


The City of Beverly Hills waste hauler is Recology. Recology provides a unique opportunity for businesses to recycle with minimal cost and effort through the use of the Material Recovery Facility (MRF) located in Sun Valley.

What's a MRF?

A MRF is a recycling facility that uses mechanical and manual sorting methods to recover and separate recyclable materials from residential and commercial collection containers prior to landfill disposal. The City of Beverly Hills residential collection has a two stream system; the black bin is for mixed waste and the green bin is for yard waste clippings. The City of Beverly Hills commercial collection is one bin for mixed waste collection and if space is available you can request a recycling bin. If your business is a restaurant or if it has significant food waste, a food waste bin can be provided.

How Does the Commercial Recycling Program Work?

The material that Recology collects is brought to the MRF, where it is weighed and placed on a conveyor belt that moves through a processing system. Equipment such as screens, magnets, and air classifiers separate recyclables into various categories. Workers also manually remove the recyclables that cannot be processed using our mechanical equipment. The recovered Materials are then bailed, and shipped to other companies for further processing.



Assembly Bill 341

California Assembly Bill (AB) 341, adopted on July 1, 2012, requires all businesses that generate four (4) or more cubic yards of garbage per week and multi-family dwellings with five (5) or more units to subscribe to

Recycling programs. Based on the City's commercial recycling program and your participation in this program, you are automatically in compliance.
