SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- 11/04/2015 At approximately 10:50PM, officers responded to an Automated License Plate Recognition notification of a stolen vehicle on Coldwater Canyon. The vehicle was located, stopped, and the driver was arrested without incident.
- 11/06/2015 Officers received an Automated License Plate Recognition notification of a vehicle used in a burglary in Sierra Madre. The vehicle was located, stopped, and two suspects were arrested. A short time later, they were transferred to Sierra Madre Police Department.
- 11/09/2015 Officers responded to a call of a grand theft which occurred in the business district. After a few minutes, several juveniles matching the description from the victim were located near Brighton Way and Rodeo Drive. After a positive identification, all juveniles were arrested and released to a guardian.
- 11/25/2015 At approximately 8:30AM, officers became involved in the pursuit of a suspicious vehicle located in the 100 block of North Swall Drive. After the pursuit, the suspects attempted to flee on foot but were subsequently captured and arrested with a stolen vehicle and stolen property.
- 11/27/2015 At approximately 11 AM, officers monitored 75 demonstrators associated with PETA near Rodeo Drive and Santa Monica Blvd. The demonstrators obeyed all laws and there were no incidents associated with their activities.
- 11/28/2015 Officers observed a suspicious vehicle in the area of Hillcrest Drive and Doheny Road. After conducting an investigation, officers arrested both occupants for possession of loaded high power assault rifles and semi-automatic hand-guns. The suspects also possessed numerous rounds of ammunition, tactical vests, ballistic trauma plates and a gas mask.

DETECTIVE BUREAU

- 11/03/2015 Romeo Wade and Jonathan Hughes appeared in L.A. Superior Court for a preliminary hearing regarding two home invasion robberies. They are accused of committing these robberies in Beverly Hills. Both defendants were held to answer for their crimes and can potentially face up to 25 years or more in state prison if found guilty during their respective trials.
- 11/06/2015 An armed robbery involving three male suspects occurred at a dry cleaning business in Beverly Hills. Using police resources, detective personnel identified the vehicle that was used during the robbery. Additional leads led to the identification of one of the three suspects. While conducting surveillance on the identified suspect, detectives witnessed him commit an armed robbery in the city of Long Beach. The suspect has since been arrested.
- 11/25/2015 A male adult and female juvenile lead police personnel on a vehicle pursuit that terminated in the Beverlywood section of Los Angeles. Both suspects fled on foot to evade capture. While on the run, the suspects committed several residential burglaries. The suspects were apprehended within an hour, and detective personnel successfully filed 11 criminal counts against the individuals with the Los Angeles County DA's Office.
- 11/25/2015 Detective personnel conducted investigations and presented 20 Beverly Hills Municipal Code (BHMC) violations to the City Attorney's Office for filing consideration during the month of November.

TRAFFIC BUREAU

- 11/16/2015 Traffic Bureau personnel implemented a Traffic Plan and assisted with site security for VPOTUS visit at the Beverly Hilton.
- 11/23/2015 Photo Red Light contract amendment was completed to include two additional approaches at the intersection of Beverly Drive and Olympic Blvd.
- 11/25/2015 Traffic Bureau supervisors met with Metro Purple Line representatives regarding the construction timeline, construction related activities, and construction traffic plans on Wilshire Blvd between San Vicente and La Cienega Blvd.
- 11/25/2015 Traffic Bureau Commander announced the appointment of four Traffic Control Officers to the pilot program that will train them in 832 Penal Code; thus enabling them to write misdemeanor citations.

11/30/2015 On-going: TCO's and Commercial Enforcement Officer continue to rove the Trousdale area to ensure compliance with the City Councils heavy hauling guidelines.

PERSONNEL & TRAINING BUREAU

12/01/2015 During the month of November, staff processed 79 entry-level and 10 lateral police applicants for the police officer position and 7 applicants for the police cadet position.
