SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- 07/01/2015 During the day, approximately twenty five member of the group PETA were peacefully protesting in the 400 block of N. Rodeo Dr. This event was monitored by the Patrol Bicycle Unit without incident.
- 07/04/2015 At approximately 4:30AM, officers responded to a window smash burglary at a business in the 9600 block of W. Olympic Blvd. Officers briefly located the suspects but lost them during a short pursuit.
- 07/07/2015 At approximately 4AM, officers responded to the 400 block of N Oakhurst Dr. for possible auto burglary suspects. A short time later after setting up a containment, two suspects were arrested.
- 07/11/2015 At approximately 2PM, officers received an ALPR notification of a carjacked vehicle in the city. The vehicle was located and stopped in the 100 block of north La Peer. All three occupants were ultimately arrested.
- 07/26/2015 At approximately 9PM, officers received an ALPR notification of a stolen vehicle near Gregory Way and La Cienega Blvd. The vehicle was located, stopped and the driver taken into custody without incident.

DETECTIVE BUREAU

- 07/15/2015 Joseph Raouf, arrested for armed bank robbery and assault on a police officer in December of 2014, appeared for his preliminary court hearing. At the conclusion of the hearing Raouf was ordered to be held over for trial on 1 misdemeanor and 10 felony counts based on his crimes.
- 07/16/2015 In May of 2015, Shahin Kianpour was arrested for manufacturing a controlled substance out of his apartment unit in a building located in the south end of the City. Kianpour's case was presented to the District Attorney's Office for filing consideration and one count of manufacturing a controlled substance was filed by the DA's Office.
- 07/29/2015 On Halloween night of 2014, a Home Invasion Robbery occurred within the 400 block of South Almont. DNA evidence recently led to the identity and arrest of at least one of the suspect believed to be involved in the robbery. On July 29, 2015, the DA's Office filed two counts of Home Invasion Robbery against Ernest Glenford Steven for his involvement in the crime.

TRAFFIC BUREAU

- 07/08/2015 Traffic Bureau supervisors met with Metro Purple Line representatives regarding the construction timeline and its impact on traffic flow on Wilshire Blvd between San Vicente and La Cienega Blvd.
- 07/21/2015 Traffic Bureau coordinated with Cal Trans to implement a traffic plan that controlled access to the area around Beverly-Wilshire, for a vice presidential visit.
- 07/31/2015 On-going TCO's & Commercial Enforcement Officer continue to rove the Trousedale area to ensure compliance with the City Councils heavy hauling guidelines.

PERSONNEL & TRAINING BUREAU

- 08/01/2015 During the month of July, staff processed 87 entry-level and 9 lateral police applicants for the police officer position and 7 applicants for the police cadet position. In addition, 3 police cadets were hired.
