## **City Commission Identifies Non-Profit in Violation of 50% Rule**

Beverly Hills, CA – A City commission that oversees charitable donations has identified another organization that consistently does not meet the City's criteria for charitable fundraising in Beverly Hills.

The National Charity League, Inc. San Fernando Valley Chapter has repeatedly failed to record net proceeds of at least 50% for their fundraising events, according to the Charitable Solicitations Commission.

"We have numerous fundraising events in the City every month and most charitable groups do meet the 50% rule," said Lillian Raffel, chairperson of the Charitable Solicitations Commission. "But the names of organizations that repeatedly record less will be publicized. People who donate to charities want to know how their money is being spent."
