SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- 01/03/2016 Officers received an Automated License Plate Reader notification of a stolen vehicle entering the city. The vehicle was located and stopped on Wilshire Blvd. After a short investigation, the driver and passenger were both taken into custody for identity theft.
- 01/04/2016 Officers made a traffic stop on a vehicle at Sunset Blvd and Mountain Dr. After observing a handgun in the vehicle, all occupants were extracted and detained. After an investigation, all suspects were arrested for conspiracy to commit robbery.
- 01/11/2016 Officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle in the vicinity of Olympic Blvd and Canon Dr. During their investigation, they located narcotics, burglary tools and evidence of fraud. All three occupants were taken into custody.
- 01/14/2016 Officers observed two suspicious vehicles in the business district around 4AM. A traffic stop was conducted and officers located burglary tools inside the vehicle. All three occupants were taken into custody.
- 01/19/2016 Officers responded to a call of a robbery in the area of Bedford Drive and Brighton Way. After searching the area, a suspect was located at 9510 Brighton Way who attempted to flee. A short time later, the suspect was detained and arrested.
- 01/24/2016 Officers responded to a call of disturbing the peace in the area of N. Crescent Dr and Santa Monica Blvd. The call was upgraded to a male hitting the victim's vehicle with a pipe. The suspect attempted to flee but was detained and arrested after a short pursuit.
- 01/28/2016 Officer responded to a call of a subject kicking in a rear door of a residence. Upon arriving, a perimeter was established. Eventually, a vehicle with five occupants was stopped nearby and all were taken into custody for the burglary.
- 01/28/2016 Officers responded to an Automated License Plate Reader alert of a stolen vehicle near Wilshire Blvd and Santa Monica Blvd. The vehicle was located, stopped and the driver arrested.

DETECTIVE BUREAU

- 02/16/2016 On December 3, 2015, Frederick Leidenfrost was arrested after completing a residential burglary within the 600 block of Foothill Road. The case was presented to the District Attorney's Office for filing consideration. The DA's Office filed one count of Burglary 459PC. Upon conviction, Leidenfrost could face as many as six years in state prison for his crime.
- 02/27/2016 Ryan Feuer entered the Starbucks located in the 9800 block of South Santa Monica and stole three items. When confronted by the store's manager, Feuer assaulted him. Feuer also fought police when they attempted to detain him for the completed robbery. Upon presenting the arrest to the DA's Office for filing consideration, Feuer was charged with (3) counts of Assault with a Deadly Weapon 245PC, (3) counts of Resisting Arrest 69PC, and Terrorist Threats 422PC.
- 01/28/2016 Isaac Childress, a male adult, was arrested for committing a residential burglary within the 1100 block of San Ysidro Drive. During the criminal investigation four of Childress' accomplices were arrested for burglary as well. All five of the individuals were charged with one count each of Burglary, 459PC by the District Attorney's Office and await their respective preliminary hearings.
- 01/31/2016 Four suspects, who traveled from Atlanta, Georgia, entered Barneys New York, located in the 9500 block of Wilshire and obtained clothing apparel while committing identity theft. All four suspects were apprehended for their involvement in the thefts. The case was presented to the District Attorney's Office and a total of (9) felony counts of Identity Theft 530.5 PC and Conspiracy 182 PC were filed against the suspects.

TRAFFIC BUREAU

- 01/06/2016 Traffic Bureau Supervisors attended the first planning meeting for the 2016 "Vanity Fair Oscar Party" that will take place on February 28th. This event will require the extended closure of the 400 block of North Crescent Drive.

- 01/06/2016 Traffic Bureau supervisors met with Metro Purple Line representatives regarding the construction timeline, construction related activities, and construction traffic plans on Wilshire Blvd between San Vicente and La Cienega Blvd.
- 01/10/2016 The 73rd Golden Globe Awards took place at the Beverly Hilton Hotel. No major incidents, related to the awards, were reported. Traffic Bureau personnel successfully implemented a new traffic plan.
- 01/19/2016 Traffic Bureau Supervisors and Photo Red Light officers met with representatives from Xerox State and Local Solutions regarding a "Plan of Action" to bring Xerox into compliance with contract requirements.
- 01/31/2016 TCO's & Commercial Enforcement Officer continue to rove the Trousdale area to ensure compliance with the City Council's heavy hauling guidelines.

PERSONNEL & TRAINING BUREAU

- 02/05/2016 During the month of January, staff processed 99 entry-level and 13 lateral police applicants for the police officer position and 9 applicants for the police cadet position. In addition, 1 Traffic Control Officer and 1 lateral Communications Dispatcher were hired during the month of January.
