Background

- State law requires all public water utilities prepare a CCR each year
- Notification of the availability of the report must be delivered no later than July 1st of each year.
- Report includes the water quality tested data in the drinking water from the previous calendar year



Electronic Distribution of the CCR

- Beverly Hills choose to publish the CCR online
 - ❖ Postcard were mailed out with the specified URL
(www.beverlyhills.org/waterquality2015)
 - ❖ Customers were given information on how to receive a hard copy upon request.
 - ❖ This saves the City from additional printing and mailing cost
 - ❖ The City prepares the report in-house which provides additional savings



Meet and Exceed Regulatory Requirements

DDW Requirements	City of Beverly Hills Performance
14 Sample Site Locations/weekly	21 Samples/weekly
Reservoir Sampling (weekly)	Test & Monitor Daily
WTP-RO Sampling (weekly)	Test & Monitor Daily
Well Samples (Monthly)	Monthly
Fluoride Sampling (Daily)	Daily
Disinfection-By-Products THMs & HAAs (Quarterly)	Quarterly
Lead & Copper Rule (Triennially)	Triennially

- Water guidelines
- Rebate information
- Landscaping Workshops
- Water Tips for landscaping and trees
- Finding Leaks on property



Brief Summary

- In 2015 the City delivered 3.4 billion gallons of high quality drinking water
- 2,698 regulatory samples were collected and approximately 31,380 samples were tested internally
- The City met 100% of all State & Federal drinking water standards
- No drinking water violations were issued
