Bike Smart Program Teaches Children Bike Safety

Beverly Hills Police Department and Community Services Launch Program on August 27

Beverly Hills, Calif. - Beverly Hills Police and Community Services Department will launch its Bike Smart Program at a Kick-Off Event on Saturday, August 27, 2016 at 9 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. at Hawthorne Elementary School, 624 North Rexford Drive. The Bike Smart Program will be held every Saturday from 9 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. at Hawthorne to teach children, three to eight years of age, who already know how to ride a bike, proper safety procedures and practice in a safe environment.

The Kick-Off Event on August 27 with the Police and Community Services staff will offer hands-on games and activities, obstacle courses, refreshments, giveaways and more. Children must be three to eight years of age, have their own bicycle and must wear a helmet. A parent/guardian will need to sign a waiver that will be collected on site during Bike Smart Program hours. To view and/or print out the form, go online to www.beverlyhills.org/bikesmart.

The Police Department will be present at the Kick-off Event as well as on September 24 and October 29 when they will offer safe riding tips and tricks. The Community Service Department will have a recreational specialist at all Bike Smart events. Bike Smart will not be offered on November 26 or December 31 due to school holidays.
