The Beverly Hills Dial-A-Ride Shuttle provides free curb-to-curb services for Beverly Hills residents, age 62 and older, or with disabilities.\* These services include:

- Medical Trips
- Supermarket Shuttle
- Non-Medical & Recreational Trips
- Monday Roxbury Shuttle



## Dial-A-Ride Service Hours

Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., with the last pick up at 3:30 p.m.

### Making Reservations

To place, change or cancel a reservation, you may call (310) 275-2791 between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Please remember to have all your appointment information ready before calling.

First time passengers must submit a copy of their photo ID and proof of Beverly Hills residency such as a current utility bill.

\*Requires an original letter from a doctor verifying a disability that prohibits driving a personal vehicle or using public transit.

## Medical Appointments



Medical trips are Dial-A-Ride's first priority! Reservations can be made up to one month in advance to any location in Beverly Hills and most medical facilities adjacent to the City, including: UCLA Medical Center, Kaiser on Cadillac Ave., and Cedars Sinai on Third St. in Los Angeles. Please schedule medical appointments at 10:00 a.m. and after; Kaiser appointments at 10:30 a.m.

If your medical appointment is running late, please call so we can make new arrangements for your return trip. Drivers will wait 3 minutes only; if you are a "No Show" your return trip will be cancelled.

Supermarket /99¢ Store Shuttle will pick you up in front of your home and take you to and from the following stores:

### Every 3rd Thursday of the Month

- **99¢ Store** at 6121 Wilshire Blvd. in Los Angeles  
Trip times Between 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., please call for exact times



You may make these shuttle reservations up to one week in advance. Passengers may have up to 5 grocery bags each. Dial-A-Ride can also take you to local Beverly Hills markets anytime during normal service hours with a reservation and space permitting.



## Non-Medical Appointments

Dial-A-Ride can provide transit service to all civic locations, the City Library and parks, shopping, or any location in Beverly Hills. Reservations can be made up to 1 week in advance on a first-come first-served basis. Our first priority is medical trips. Dial-A-Ride is busiest on Mondays, so please consider making non-medical trips on Tuesday through Friday. We appreciate your understanding and flexibility.

Dial-A-Ride also provides expanded service to Roxbury Park for the Monday Active Adult Meetings. Just make a reservation one week in advance. Pick-ups start at 9:30 a.m., with the return trip scheduled at approximately 2:15 p.m.

## Additional Provisions . . .

Dial-A-Ride is a **shared ride service**, so you may share your ride with other passengers. Please allow a 15 minute window to your scheduled pick-up time. If you wait longer than 15 minutes, please call (310) 275-2791.

Many users depend on the Dial-A-Ride for important trips. If your plans change, please cancel your scheduled reservation as soon as possible so we can offer services to additional passengers on the waiting list.

To assure your safety, please do not distract the driver.

## Taxi Coupon Program

Seniors, age 65 and older, or disabled residents with certain medical conditions,\* may purchase one taxi coupon book each month worth \$24.00 for only **\$6.00**.

To register for the Taxi-Coupon Program, send proof of your birthdate and residency (e.g., a copy of your photo ID card & utility bill) to the address below.

Residents aged 62 and older or disabled\* are eligible for a monthly discounted bus pass for **\$7.00**. Passes may be purchased Monday through Friday, from the 25<sup>th</sup> of each month to the 10<sup>th</sup> of the following month.
