SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- 12/03/2015 At approximately 7PM, officers responded to noises heard in the 600 block of North Foothill Road. Upon arrival, two suspects fled the location. One was immediately caught after a foot pursuit and all stolen property were recovered at the location.
- 12/07/2015 At approximately 11AM, officers responded to a burglary which occurred at Saks Fifth Avenue Department store. The suspects fled the location and officers set up a containment. After a K-9 search, both suspects were located and taken into custody.
- 12/16/2015 At approximately 3:30PM, officers responded to Lexington Road regarding a subject jumping a fence. A containment and search was conducted. The suspect was taken into custody for burglary.
- 12/16/2015 At approximately 1PM, officers received an alert of a stolen vehicle driving south on Coldwater Canyon Blvd. The vehicle was eventually located, stopped and a brief investigation revealed the driver had a replica firearm and a large quantity of marijuana. The driver was arrested.
- 12/21/2015 At approximately 1:30AM, officers contacted two subjects in the 300 block of South Rexford/Elm Drive alley. After an investigation, two additional subjects were located along with stolen property and a firearm. All four were taken into custody.

DETECTIVE BUREAU

- 12/07/2015 A minor was awaiting a court appearance in the Los Angeles County Juvenile Courts for a commercial burglary he committed in November of 2015 in Beverly Hills. He was then arrested for committing a robbery in Beverly Hills. Both cases have been presented to the District Attorney's Office which included an enhancement charge based on the juvenile's known street gang affiliation.
- 12/08/2015 In May of 2015, a male suspect approached a female motorist, seated in her car with her two young children, swung a baseball bat and threatened to harm her. In fear of for her life, the female motorist sped away. Through extensive detective follow-up, a DNA profile was obtained for the suspect. Steps are now being taken to locate the now known suspect to arrest him for the crime of Assault with a Deadly Weapon.
- 12/11/2015 A carjacking occurred in the southeast section of Beverly Hills. Detective personnel were able to identify the suspect responsible for the crime through investigative efforts. Filing charges for this incident are pending with the LA County DA's Office; however, the suspect is currently in custody for also committing the carjacking of a passenger bus in the City of Glendale within three days of the Beverly Hills incident.
- 12/30/2015 During the month of December, detective personnel successfully filed 37 Municipal Code violations with the City Attorney's office. The filings included 15 for violating the No Camping ordinance; 7 for sitting or lying within a public walkway; and 4 for abandoning personal property within a public walkway.

TRAFFIC BUREAU

- 12/07/2015 A TCO Supervisor and two TCO's attended a weeklong class on 832 PC as part of a pilot program that will enable them to write misdemeanor citations for vending trucks and other violations.
- 12/08/2015 Traffic Officers responded to a vehicle vs. pedestrian traffic accident that occurred on Foothill and 3rd which resulted in the pedestrian passing away due to his injuries on 12/15/15.
- 12/31/2015 On-going: TCO's and Commercial Enforcement Officer continue to rove the Trousdale area to ensure compliance with the City Councils heavy hauling guidelines.

PERSONNEL & TRAINING BUREAU

01/06/2016 During the month of December, staff processed 80 entry-level and 9 lateral police applicants for the police officer position and 9 applicants for the police cadet position.
